It actively works towards diminishing waterborne diseases like cholera and dysentery, which stem from unclean water sources. The entire cost of drilling and constructing a borehole in Uganda amounts to \$8,124, and any contribution toward this vital initiative is greatly appreciated.

# Feed a Family

Disturbingly, one in three schoolchildren faces the heartwrenching reality of going without food during their school day. This lack of proper nutrition is at the core of ongoing nutritional issues, which negatively impact the health, growth, and development of Ugandan children. The 2013 Comprehensive Food Security & Vulnerability Analysis (CFSVA), conducted by the World Food Program (WFP) in Uganda, exposed that roughly 5 percent of households in the country endure inadequate or non-existent food intake. Additionally, 16 percent of households possess borderline food consumption, characterized by diets that are slightly more diverse but still lack proper nutrition. Tragically, this has led to increased mortality rates due to hunger and famine. As an organization, we extend an invitation to join forces with us in the battle against hunger. Surprisingly, a gift as small as \$12 has the power to provide a child with nourishment, clothing, and shelter for an entire day.
